

# Attorney and former detective question original Weinckowski autopsy

An autopsy performed by the Erie County Medical Examiner's office on Amanda L. Wienckowski, the woman found frozen in a trash tote in January 2009, missed key clues that prove she was murdered, according to former Buffalo homicide cold case Detective Dennis Delano and Wienckowski family attorney Steven Cohen.
